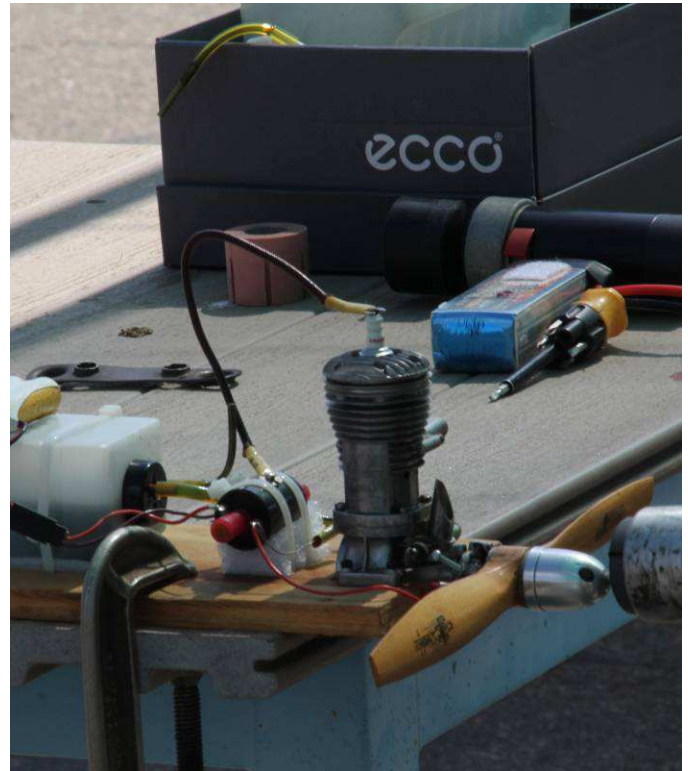
How about some aerial stuff - drone pictures or video of the field?
